Project Description	On the basis of full assessment of the condition of the pumping stations in the country, restore and replace irrigation pumps and motors and refurbish the Abu Sabkha pumping stations.				

Development Goal and Immediate Objectives

Improve food security and rural livelihoods by contributing to the better water supply of some 36,550 donums of agricultural land and 8 000 of households within the areas' rural communities.

Outputs, Key activities and Procurement

Outputs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Deliver the pumps and equipment to the project site in Iraq, installation, commissioning and testing. - Operation and maintenance of Water Recourses activities - Training of MoWR staff in management, plus transfer of technology to MoWR technical staff, operators and maintenance personnel.
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - General inventory and condition assessment - Rehabilitation of Pumping Stations; providing 4 spiral pumps with a delivery of 1, 47 m3/sec each (total 5.88 m3/sec) with all of its mechanical and electrical accessories, and when the pumping station become fully operational with its full efficiency the supply of water to the irrigation area will be fully restored - Training of and technology transfer to MoWR technical staff.
